Manufacturing fertilizers, mineral acids coefficients, chemical crops. -6

- .Working in filling cylinders with pressurised gases -7
- .Processes for melting fat and making wax -8

Work at mines and quarr -9ies.

- .Manufacturing dyes and varnish -10
- .Foundry -11
- .Making glue -12
- .Making glass -13
- .Sugar manufacturing and refining -14
- .Making and packaging bleach and chalk -15

Oil squeezing industry using mechanical methods -16.
